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Instructions

Instructions to the student for completing the AMP Pre-admission Readiness Form

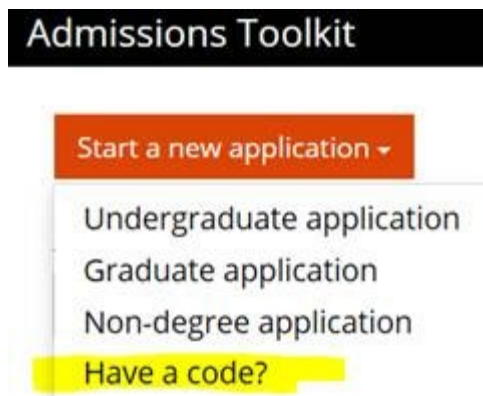
1. Fill out the all sections of the form as completely as possible.
2. List the graduate-level courses you hope to take while still an undergraduate student in the "AMP Courses" section, filling in the term you hope to take each course.
3. List as many "Future Graduate Courses" as you may now know.
4. Write a brief statement of the graduate research or project objectives and/or goals for your graduate program in the space provided. If not known at this time, you may write, TBD. If you are pursuing a master's degree that is not research-based, write Not Applicable in this space.

Instructions for obtaining signatures on the AMP Pre-admission Readiness Form

1. This form may be signed with wet ink or routed through DocuSign for signatures. Depending on your program, your undergrad advisor or your AMP Advisor should be able to help with that DocuSign routing.
2. Not all forms will require all signatures, check with your program's AMP Advisor regarding who needs to sign your form.
3. The last person to sign this form will be your AMP Advisor.
4. Your AMP Advisor will provide, along with their signature, an AMP application code.

Instructions for applying to AMP

1. Go to OSU's Admissions Toolkit application website: <https://oregonstate.force.com/AppLogin>. This is the same site you used when you applied to OSU as a freshman or transfer student, so while you may not remember your login password, you almost certainly will not have to create a new account.
2. Choose "Have a code?" rather than "Graduate application" from the "Start a new application" menu in the Admissions Toolkit.
3. Input the code your AMP Advisor provided.



4. When asked, **be sure to apply for the future term in which you will begin graduate school**, not the term you plan to start taking graduate-level courses. Later in the application, you will be asked what your AMP Start Term is.
5. In the AMP application, upload this form, fully signed, when asked for your AMP "Plan of Study."
